

Pathways to activating National and Regional Alliances:

1. Identify Priority regions and nations
 - a. National leaders emerging through catching vision and who are influencers, motivated to collaborate for their regions and nations
 - b. Areas where there is greatest need based on unevangelized populations, number of UPGs/UUPGs, lack of collaborative strategy
 - c. Neighboring countries to existing alliances - whether national or regional
 - d. GACX member orgs interested in partnership in specific locations and willing to champion/seed national/regional alliances
2. Activate Alliances
 - a. Consult with other Networks
 - Are other networks active in the region? What do they know?
 - b. Communicate with prospective leaders and determine road map and timings
 - Develop relationships and expectations
 - c. Connect leaders
 - Host exploratory meetings (virtual and then face to face)
 1. Begin with member orgs present in region/nation
 2. Invite national influencers
 - d. Commit
 - Appoint leader
 - Build team
 - Launch
 1. Regional or national alliance forum
 2. Determine initial collaborative projects (short term, high gain, low risk)
 3. Determine long term strategy with clear goals (lag and lead measures)
 4. Determine resources needed
