These prompts build unity and seek the Lord's direction for church multiplication, collaboration & impactful global witness, and Christ is magnified & glorified through the Forum. The event's purpose is ultimately Jesus, not the program or production.

A wonderful song of worship to pray that the Holy Spirit—not our plans—would guide our annual conference, and for the Lord's presence to be known by all. We invite God's presence and leadership at Forum 2026.

Prayers for Specific Needs:

(DAY 1 - 30) Use or adapt these prompts to guide personal and corporate intercession, empowering lasting kingdom impact at the GACX Annual Forum:

DAY

1. Pray that everyone God wants at this year's Forum will register before the deadlines of 9/7 for lodging and 9/14 for event registration.
2. Ask God to provide the timely resources needed—funding, interviews, visas, paperwork, scheduling—for each person and ministry attending.
3. Lift up the GACX Staff & Event Team in all aspects of the planning, development and implementation of the Forum, and that God takes control of every detail and gets the glory.
4. Ask the Lord to continue to bless the Dallas / Grapevine community, and the team at Embassy Suites Grapevine as they prepare for and help support our event.
5. Pray for safe travels, good health, weather, and God's blessing on every participant as they prepare & travel to the Forum.



6. Pray for hearts to be open to hear God's voice and receive His direction as we all prepare and participate in this conference.
7. Ask God to unite all participants in love and purpose, transcending cultural and denominational differences from all global regions.
 - Prayers for Leaders and Speakers
8. Lift up our GACX leaders, Bekele Shanko & Joey Shaw, that they would have health, wisdom, boldness, stamina & guidance from the Holy Spirit.
9. Pray for sensitivity for each Forum Speaker and Facilitator to discern the Holy Spirit's leading throughout each session.
10. Ask God to grant supernatural protection and health to all staff, speakers, volunteers & participants serving during the Forum.
 - Prayers for Sessions and Gathering
11. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide every plenary, workshop, and conversation so God's agenda prevails above all else.
12. Pray for effective, fruitful exchange of ideas and prayer between global ministry leaders during Regional Conversations.
13. Intercede for individual spiritual renewal and encounters with God in moments of worship, prayer, and fellowship.
 - Prayers for Collaboration and Partnerships
14. Ask God to bless existing & new kingdom partnerships and collaborative initiatives for global church multiplication.
15. Pray that God would reveal global needs and resources during Collaboration Marketplace.
16. Intercede for humility and openness to learn from one another, setting aside personal agendas for the greater advancement of God's kingdom.
 - Prayers for Church Multiplication
17. Pray for the vision: a healthy, multiplying, and sustainable church for every 1,000 people on earth.
18. Ask God to call and equip more leaders and teams for church planting efforts in all unreached areas.



19. Intercede for spiritual awakening and gospel receptivity in all regions with few or no healthy churches.
 - Prayers for Challenges and Barriers
20. Ask God to break down barriers—spiritual, cultural, political, or financial—that hinder multiplication and unity.
21. Pray for protection from division, misunderstanding, competition or distraction during the Forum.
22. Lift up regions experiencing persecution or hardship, that they may experience care and support by the global body.
 - Prayers for the Global Church
23. Pray for the strengthening of churches worldwide: their unity, witness, multiplication and perseverance.
24. Intercede for those suffering for their faith and for God's comfort on the persecuted and oppressed.
25. Ask that the global church would be a bright witness of Christ's love, hope, joy and faith in every context of sharing the gospel.
 - Prayers for Lasting Impact
26. Pray for lasting transformation in every participant, that what is learned and experienced will be multiplied in their home ministries and nations.
27. Ask for boldness for participants to pursue new visions and action steps following the Forum.
28. Pray for safe travels, spiritual protection, and perseverance as participants return to their fields of influence.
 - Responsive and Relational Prayers
29. Ask God to raise up new prayer and church planting movements across countries and languages as a result of the Forum.
30. Bless the continued connections and collaborations of the GACX Members & Partners, and God would be glorified!



Scriptures:

As we prepare for the Forum, these Bible passages are especially meaningful because they focus on seeking God, unity, wisdom, and readiness:

Psalms 90:17 (A Prayer for God's Favor)

"May the favor of the Lord our God rest on us; establish the work of our hands for us—yes, establish the work of our hands."

Why it's fitting: A wonderful prayer before the Forum, asking God to bless every detail and make the gathering fruitful.

Colossians 3:23–24

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters..."

Theme: Serving with excellence and wholehearted devotion.

Proverbs 16:3

"Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and he will establish your plans."

Theme: Surrendering every plan and decision to God.

Isaiah 40:31

"But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength..."

Theme: Receiving strength and endurance during a busy season of preparation and implementation.

Philippians 2:1–4

"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves..."

Theme: Unity and servant-hearted teamwork.

Ephesians 3:20–21

"Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine..."

Theme: Trusting God to exceed our expectations.

Theme: Seeking God's wisdom in planning, processing, and presenting.
